





Perennials

Aster - Kickin 'Carmine Red' (Aster - Kickin 'Carmine Red')

This variety of aster forms a dense mound of green foliage, with a blanket of flowers that bloom from late summer into fall. It creates a show of beautiful color later in the season!

SIZE: 24"-36" LOCATION: Sun

BLOOM TIME: August, September **FLOWER COLOR:** Red, Pink







Aster Alert (Aster novi-belgi 'Alert')

Closely compacted perennial this aster has a fan-like arrangement of brilliant, daisy-like flowers. It works in rock gardens, borders, butterfly gardens, or containers - just about anywhere. Left alone the plants spread into open mounds as they mature.

Take off half of the entire plant in mid-June. This prevents early blooming and drooping flowers.

Late in the fall or in the spring prune to ground level.

SIZE: 15 inches x 24 inches **LOCATION:** Sun, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: August, September, October

SOIL CONDITIONS: moist

FLOWER COLOR: Deep purple-ish red







Aster KICKIN 'Lavender' (Aster KICKIN 'Lavender')

This variety of aster forms a dense mound of green foliage, with a blanket of flowers that bloom from late summer into fall. It creates a show of beautiful color later in the season!

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 24"-36" LOCATION: Sun

BLOOM TIME: August, September, October

FLOWER COLOR: Lavender







Aster Stokes' (Stokesia)

This perennial aster produces 4 inch purple flowers with white stamens on purplish stems and blooms June-August. Grows 12-18 inches tall and attracts butterflies! Works well as a cut flower. Plant in small groupings. Use it in rock gardens or at border points or in cottage gardens.

Cut back to the ground in Spring

SIZE: 12-18 inches

LOCATION: Sun and Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July, August

SOIL CONDITIONS: Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Purple, Blue









Aster, Purple Dome (Aster n.a. 'Purple Dome')

Appearing as masses of solid royal purple from late summer into fall, these asters form wonderfully compact, rounded mounds. They are terrific accents for fall blooming grasses and the changing colors of the trees. Try cutting a few of the tall, flowering stems for a fresh bouquet—bring the outdoors in.

To promote dense growth that is less likely to flop, pinch plants back from late spring until July 4th.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18-24 inches LOCATION: Sun

BLOOM TIME: August, September

SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Purple







Aster-Short (Aster X Dumosus)

This aster perennial blooms profusely with pink, purple, red or white from Sept thru Oct. Grows 12 inches -24 inches tall. Very hardy! Well-suited for your butterfly garden but does exceptionally well as a border planting. You may choose to put it in containers and, like many other asters, it does well as a cut flower.

Watch for aphids, spray as needed.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts. Also trim half way back in June to set back bloom time to Aug to Oct.

SIZE: 12-24 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Sun
BLOOM TIME: September, October
SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Pink, Red, Purple, White







Aster-Tall (Aster)

This perennail blooms red, pink, or purple beginning in September and lasting through October. It grows 3-4' tall and is considered very hardy. You will find it attracts butterflies and like other asters, may be used as a cut flower. Place it in your cottage or butterfly garden. Try it in containers or use it as part of your border planting.

Watch for aphids, spray as needed.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts. Trim half way back in June to set bloom time to Sept. - Oct.

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Sun
BLOOM TIME: September, October
SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium
FLOWER COLOR: Purple, Pink







Baptisia (False Indigo) (Baptisia)

Showy, sun-loving perennials with blue flowers on 1 ft spikes. The flowers are held above the foliage. Attractive seed pods hang from fall thru winter unless the plant is trimmed to re-shape. False Indigo is great in prairie areas, meadows and areas where you want the natural look to prevail.

Cut to the ground in Spring

SIZE: 36-48 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun
BLOOM TIME: April, May
SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium

FLOWER COLOR: Blue, purple, yellow







Baptisia (Lemon Meringue) (Baptisia)

An upright shape of blue-green foliage, is topped with stunning yellow flowers. Charcoal stems and buds carry these flowers, to create this magnificent display.

Cut to the ground in Spring

SIZE: 36 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun BLOOM TIME: April, May FLOWER COLOR: Yellow







Baptisia Pink Lemonade (Baptisia Decadence Deluxe 'Pink Lemonade')

A beautiful bicolor Baptisia! Soft yellow flowers will turn a dusty raspberry color as they age; even showing both colors at the same time! Charcoal colored stems make these colors stand out to create a beautiful display!

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 36"-48"

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun
BLOOM TIME: May, June
FLOWER COLOR: Yellow, Purple







Coral Bell - Apple Twist (Heuchera DOLCE 'Apple Twist')

This coral bell puts on a show of color as it changes through the season. chartreuse-yellow leaves mature to green, as the red veins lighten to bring a true show of colors!

Trim back as needed in the early spring, semi-evergreen

SIZE: 18"

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: July FLOWER COLOR: Pink





Coral Bell - Black Pearl (Heuchera 'Black Pearl')

This coral bell forms a dense habit of jet black leaves with purple undersides. It keeps its intense color even in full sun!

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen.

SIZE: 18 - 20 inches

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Dry







Coral Bell - Blackberry Ice (Heuchera Dolce 'Blackberry Ice')

This Coral Bell forms a clump of iridescent purple leaves with black veining throughout. Foliage creates a pewter overlay with cream colored flowers in the summer.

SIZE: 20"-26" **BLOOM TIME:** July

FLOWER COLOR: White, Cream







Coral Bell - Caramel (Heuchera 'Caramel')

A popular coral bell, chosen for its beautiful dense foliage. Forms large fuzzy leaves ranging from apricot to amber.

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen.

SIZE: 12 - 14 inches

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium to Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Cream











Coral Bell - Electric Plum (Heuchera 'Electric Plum')

Near black leaves emerge and eventually lighten to a bright purple color with black veins. Fuschia-pink flowers give this coral bell even more color that is sure to please everyone!

Trim back as needed in the early spring, semi-evergreen

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Low Moisture

FLOWER COLOR: Pink





Coral Bell - Georgia Peach (Heuchera 'Georgia Peach')

Peach colored leaves with a light silver overlay create a spectacular display. Makes a great specimen plant!

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen.

SIZE: 14 - 18 inches

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: June

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium to Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Cream









Coral Bell - Grape Expectations (Heuchera 'Grape Expectations')

A very uniform Coral Bell that boasts thick, vibrant grape purple leaves. It develops a bright silver overlay during the heat of the summer.

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen.

SIZE: 12 - 18 inches

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: June

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium to Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Cream







Coral Bell - Lava Lamp (Heuchera 'Lava Lamp')

This Coral Bell is a robust grower which sprouts copper orange foliage in spring, which turn deep purple in the early summer. Foliage is topped with cream flowers in the early summer.

Trim back as needed in the early spring, semi-evergreen

SIZE: 18" - 24"

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: June **FLOWER COLOR:** Cream





Coral Bell - Pretty Pistachio (Heuchera 'Pretty Pistachio')

The leaves on this coral bell start out as chartreuse in the spring, and turn lime green in the summer. Wide clusters of pink flowers appear all summer long!

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen.

SIZE: 18 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: June, July, August **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium to Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Pink









Coral Bell - Timeless Glow (Heuchera 'Timeless Glow')

A revolution in Heuchera genetics! You'll be amazed at the unbelievable flower production of our new 'Timeless Glow'. A myriad of light pink flowers which age to a deeper rose red are produced in tight wands on 18-20" scapes. What is so remarkable is what happens when the flowers are spent—they dry in place on the stems similar to what Statice does instead of falling off and leaving bare stems, thus the reference to the everlasting flowers in its name. You'll get a two toned look of light and dark pink flowers on the same plant for a strong show of color. Even better, this plant blooms and reblooms continuously, not in waves, from early summer to frost!

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen

SIZE: 18-20 inches

LOCATION: Full shade, Part Shade

BLOOM TIME: June, July, August, September, October

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium FLOWER COLOR: Pink







Coral Bell - Wild Rose (Heuchera Primo 'Wild Rose')

Bright purple leaves with charcoal gray veining form a dense, colorful mound. Dark burgundy buds open to rosy pink flowers for even more color in the summer!

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18"-22"

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun, Shade

BLOOM TIME: July FLOWER COLOR: Pink











Coral Bell - Wildberry (Heuchera DOLCE 'Wildberry')

Large, purple, glossy leaves have charcoal veins that really make the color of this coral bell pop!

Trim back as needed in the early spring, semi-evergreen

SIZE: 18" - 24"

LOCATION: Full Sun, Partial Sun SOIL CONDITIONS: Low moisture





Coral Bell - Yellow leafed variety (Heuchera)

A yellow leafed variety of coral bell blooming pink. Can tolerate more sun than typical purple leaf varieties.

Trim off old foliage in early Spring.

SIZE: 12-14 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Part shade BLOOM TIME: May, June, July SOIL CONDITIONS: medium FLOWER COLOR: pink











Coral Bell, Sunny Variety (Heuchera)

Saucy is a word to describe this coral bell, a slightly ruffled foliage of purple, bronze, silver or chartuese. This semi-evergreen needs very little space as its habitat. You can use them in a variety of settings.

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen

SIZE: 12 inches

BLOOM TIME: May and June
SOIL CONDITIONS: medium

FLOWER COLOR: white, pink or red







Coral Bell-Palace Purple (Heuchera Micrantha)

Start and end your summer with this brilliant purple foliage. It peaks with white blooms in June and July. Overall this perennial grows to 12-18 inches tall and makes quite a statement for a relatively small perennial.

Cut back as needed in Spring, as it is a semi-evergreen

SIZE: 12-18 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Shade BLOOM TIME: June, July SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium FLOWER COLOR: White







Daylily - Special (Hemerocallis)

The perennial daylily known as "Special" produces masses of a variety of colors of flowers, ranging from purple, pink, red, peach, and orange. Once it is all grown up it is16-30 inches tall. The vibrancy show runs June through July.

cut off flower stalk after it is finished blooming.

Snap off dead blooms; cut flower stem to ground after all flowers are spent. Pull out dead leaves throughout the season. Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts. SIZE: 16-30 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Purple, pink, red, peach, orange











Daylily-Stella de Oro (Hemerocallis)

When you say "daylily" most people envision Stella. Yell it our "STELLA"! There, now you feel better and can set about making the decision as to how many of this dwarf ever-blooming daylily you are going to add this year. It's a keeper - time has proven that. The flowers are gold, thus Stella's last name of de Oro. Very carefree plant! Translate that to be spunky. You'll see these ablaze in many lawns, looking up to the younger models but holding their ground firmly committed to being beautiful.

Snap off dead blooms; cut flower stem to ground after all flowers are spent. Pull out dead leaves throughout the season. Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts. SIZE: 15 inches **LOCATION:** Sun

BLOOM TIME: May, June, July, August, September,

October

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Dry

FLOWER COLOR: Gold











Grass - Karl Foerster (Calamagrostis)

This is a reed grass which produces showy, feathery plumes bearing striking, erect, wheat-colored seed heads. Its vertical presence is magnificent, reaching 4-5 ft tall; it only gets a spread of 2 feet! Works well as a cut flower or mix it up for a natural bouquet.

Cut back to the ground in early Spring

SIZE: 4-5' x 2' spread **LOCATION:** Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist

FLOWER COLOR: Golden







Hibiscus (Hibiscus)

Hibiscus plants are perennial favorites for many people. They are hardy 3-5 ft tall plants with large (up to 10 inches) blooms, drawing attention wherever they live. Colors range from red, pink, and white and flowers adorn your landscape for an extended summertime!

Hibiscus is one of the last perennials to appear in the spring. Watch for japanese beetles. Spray as needed or treat with soil drench in the spring and fall.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall x 3-5 ft spread

LOCATION: Sun

BLOOM TIME: July, August, September SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist, Wet FLOWER COLOR: Red, Pink, White







Hibiscus - Cranberry Crush (Hibiscus)

A hardy hibiscus that is compact in size! The flower buds are nearly black and open to a deep scarlet red that are 7-8 inches in diameter. The leaves are leathery and maple like with a hint of purple.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall by 4-5 ft wide **LOCATION:** Sun, partial sun

BLOOM TIME: July, August, September **SOIL CONDITIONS:** medium, moist

FLOWER COLOR: red







Hibiscus - Perfect Storm (Hibiscus Summerific 'Perfect Storm')

This Hibiscus is perfect for a smaller garden! 'Perfect Storm' only reaches 36", but still has all of the beauty and color of your typical hibiscus. The 8" flowers are white to pink, with a bright red center that radiates out.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 36"

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun BLOOM TIME: July, August FLOWER COLOR: White, Pink







Hibiscus - Tie Dye (Hibiscus)

Showy ruffled, bright pink flowers with a white bull's eye and a cherry red center. The flowers are 8-10 inch in size! The leaves are maple like and green.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 4-5 ft tall by 5-6 ft wide **LOCATION**: Sun, partial sun

BLOOM TIME: July, August, September **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium, moist

FLOWER COLOR: pink







Hibiscus Candy Crush (Hibiscus summerific 'Candy Crush')

This beautiful hibiscus features bright pink blooms with a deep red center. Blooms stand out against bright green leaves.

Trim to the ground in late fall or early spring after several frosts

SIZE: 4' - 5'

LOCATION: Full Sun BLOOM TIME: July, August FLOWER COLOR: Pink





Hibiscus Midnight Marvel (Hibiscus 'Midnight Marvel')

Stunning, scarlet red blooms stand out against the deep wine-purple foliage. This hibiscus will stay a bit smaller than most varieties, standing about 4' tall and wide.

Trim to the ground in late fall or early spring after several frosts

SIZE: 48"

LOCATION: Full Sun BLOOM TIME: July, August FLOWER COLOR: Red





Hibiscus Starry Night (Hibiscus 'Starry Starry Night')

This variety of hibiscus has a wonderful display of colors! The bright pink flowers have a radiating red center, the really shine against the dark foliage.

Standing at 4' tall, this hibiscus is a real show-stopper!

Trim to the ground in late fall or early spring after several frosts

LOCATION: Full Sun BLOOM TIME: July, August FLOWER COLOR: Pink





Hibiscus, 'Berry Awesome' (Hibiscus)

A densely compact hardy hibiscus that blooms a lavender pink and has midnight olive foliage. A show stopper!

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 4 ft

LOCATION: SUn, Part Sun

BLOOM TIME: July, August, September **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Moist, Medium **FLOWER COLOR:** lavender pink







Hosta - Cool as a Cucumber (Hosta)

A quick growing hosta that has long tapered leaves with bright green margins and white centers. This hosta matures to a gracefully arching mound. Light lavender flowers.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 28-40 inches LOCATION: May, June SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist FLOWER COLOR: lavender







Hosta - Afterglow (Hosta 'Afterglow')

Heart-shaped leaves feature wide, yellow margins on striking green leaves. Forms an upright mound to create a beautiful specimen plant in the landscape.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 24"-36" LOCATION: Shade BLOOM TIME: June

FLOWER COLOR: Lavender







Hosta - Autumn Frost (Hosta Shadowland 'Autumn Frost')

Leaves first emerge as frosty blue-green with wide yellow margins in spring; then turn green with creamy white margins in the summer. The striking colors that this hosta creates are a beautiful addition to any landscape!

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 12"-16" LOCATION: Shade BLOOM TIME: July

FLOWER COLOR: Lavender







Hosta - Blue Angel (Hosta)

Hosta is the best group of plants for shade and this is an excellent example of how a shade area can flourish! Large leafy perennial with blue foliage. You'll find it blooms July thru August, lovely flowers but still this one is grown primarily for the leaves. Grows 36-48 inches tall making it one of the largest hostas you'll ever own.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 36-48 inches **LOCATION:** Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist

FLOWER COLOR: White





Hosta - Blue Ivory (Hosta)

This is a type of Halcyon hosta. It has extra wide creamy white borders and a blue center in spring. Margins brighten to white and may develop a green blush while the center turns blue-green in summer. Its lavender flowers make their appearance mid-summer which only further serves to label this plant as a delight to the eyes.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 16-24 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium-Moist FLOWER COLOR: Lavender





Hosta - Blueberry Muffin



Hosta - Blueberry Muffin (Hosta 'Blueberry Muffin')

A short hosta with a beautiful blue leaf. The rounded leaves are puckered with different textures, to create an attractive addition to any shady area.

Trim to the ground in late fall or early spring after several frosts

SIZE: 18" tall x 36" wide

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade





Hosta - Brother Stefan (Hosta)

This hosta forms a large clump of thick, heavily corrugated leaves. The leaves have a golden center with green margins. White flowers accompany this hosta in mid-summer.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 24 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist

FLOWER COLOR: white







Hosta - Christmas Candy (Hosta 'Christmas Candy')

This hosta has long, narrow green leaves with a wide, white center. It's a fast grower with lavender flowers on 22 inch scapes in the summer.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 24"

LOCATION: Shade **BLOOM TIME:** July

FLOWER COLOR: Lavender







Hosta - Church Mouse (Hosta)

This hosta can easily be distinguished by its coarsely wavy leaves. It forms a cute miniature clump of thick, blue-green to green leaves and matures into a small, compact mound that is just the right size for troughs or the front of the border. Perfectly proportioned scapes carry the lavender flowers in early summer.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 12-14 inches

LOCATION: Part to Full Shade **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium, moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Purple







Hosta - Curly Fries (Hosta)

This hosta has a mound-like form with rippled, narrow leaves. The golden color of this hosta is brightest when grown in areas that receive morning sun. Lavender flowers accompany the leaves in midsummer.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 16 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender







Hosta - Dancing Queen (Hosta)

A unique yellow hosta that emerges bright yellow and remains yellow all season. Large leaves display a pie crust edge.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 18 inches tall by 28 inches wide

LOCATION: Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August

SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist - medium **FLOWER COLOR:** pale lavender





Hosta - Earth Angel (Hosta)

Go for this knockout hosta! Perfect in your perennial garden, this is a type of Blue Angel hosta. Large, heart-shaped, blue-green leaves with wide, creamy-white/yellow margins.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 30-40 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium - Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** pale lavender





Hosta - Empress Wu (Hosta 'Empress Wu')

Who'd have thought there would be a hosta so large? This one is an impressive giant, named in honor of the only woman emperor of China. It towers over others, has a rich, deep, full green leaf. Give it plenty of room! It is a highly sought hosta. Where is yours going?

Keep the soil CONSISTENTLY moist.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 5 ft tall x 5 ft spread **LOCATION**: Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Moist

FLOWER COLOR: Pale reddish-violet





Hosta - Guacamole (Hosta)

Hosta la vista - or something like that (smile). The huge apple-green/guacamole colored leaves display with dark green streaks. Leaf centers become brighter gold in summer. Fragrant white flowers add to the showiness.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 24 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Sun **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist

FLOWER COLOR: White







Hosta - Hadspen Blue (Hosta)

A magnificent blue hosta which holds its color longer than many other blues. A bit of morning sun enhances the coloring. Its powdery, steel blue leaves are of heavy substance. this is one of the best available. Pair it with some Brunnera.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 14-18 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium - Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** pale lavender





Hosta - Hudson Bay (Hosta)

A hosta with wide, bright blue margins and apple green streaks, thru the creamy white leaf centers. The leaves are heavy.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 24 inches tall by 26 inches wide

LOCATION: Shade **BLOOM TIME:** June

SOIL CONDITIONS: medium - moist

FLOWER COLOR: white





Hosta - Ivory Queen (Hosta)

This hosta forms a mound of cream to white leaves with blue-green margins and a dash of green. The flowers are pale lavender.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

Hosta - Krossa Regal (Hosta 'Krossa Regal')

Grey-green leaves form this vase-shaped hosta. Wavy leaves create a unique texture that gives this hosta some great character!

Trim to the ground in late fall or early spring after several frosts

SIZE: 36" - 48" LOCATION: Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender





Hosta - Mayflower Moon (Hosta)

This brightly colored hosta has chartreuse leaves that turn yellow in summer. The leaves are heavily textured and round. Pale lavender flowers on a medium sized hosta.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18 inches tall x 24 inch spread

LOCATION: Shade

SOIL CONDITIONS: medium to moist **FLOWER COLOR:** pale lavender







Hosta - Paradigm (Hosta)

A hosta with beatiful gold leaves with streaked, bluegreen margin; variegation gets bolder later n spring. Slug resistant.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 20 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium - Moist

FLOWER COLOR: purple





Hosta - Patriot (Hosta)

Dark green leaves with white streaked margins. Somewhat sun tolerant and very distinctive. Lavender flowers.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 24 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Shade **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender





Hosta - Paul's Glory (Hosta)

Leaves are blue-green with a chartreuse center in spring. By summer, they turn dark green and centers brighten to gold.

Trim to ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 25-40 inches

LOCATION: Shade, Partial Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium - Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** pale lavender





Hosta - Rainbow's End (Hosta 'Rainbow's End')

This unique hosta exhibits incredibly variegated, shiny foliage. The bright yellow leaves of good substance have dark green margins that jet into the center, and the center brightens to creamy white in summer. It forms a medium sized mound of attractive foliage in the landscape. In late summer, showy red scapes carry the dark lavender, tubular flowers.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 16-19 inches

LOCATION: Full shade, Part Shade **BLOOM TIME:** August, September **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium, moist

FLOWER COLOR: Purple





Hosta - Regal Splendor (Hosta)

Vase shaped with blue leaves and yellow variegation. Slug resistant. Grows to 36 inches at maturity. Flower stalks grow to 60 inches tall.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 36 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Shade **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender







Hosta - Revolution (Hosta)

A thick leafed hosta with broad dark green leaves, cream centered speckled with green. Lavender flowers.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18-24 inches LOCATION: shade BLOOM TIME: June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist, medium **FLOWER COLOR:** lavender







Hosta - Rhino Hide (Hosta 'Rhino Hide')

You have to feel it to believe it! "The texture and substance of the leaves remind you of a rhino's hide—thick and unusual". Slugs can't touch 'Rhino Hide'! Leaves of extremely thick substance have wide, blue margins and a narrow, light green center that brightens to yellow. They are cupped and puckered, forming a medium to large sized clump in the landscape. White flowers top the scapes in early to midsummer. This durable hosta exhibits greater sun tolerance than many other hostas, though partial shade is still best.

Trim to ground after several frosts.

SIZE: 20-30 inches

LOCATION: Full to Part Shade **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium, moist.

FLOWER COLOR: White





Hosta - Sagae (Hosta)

A vase shaped plant having heart-shaped leaves, frosty green centers with yellow on edges. Slug resistant. Grows to 28 inches at maturity.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 28 inches x 50 inches LOCATION: Partial Sun, Shade BLOOM TIME: June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender





Hosta - Sum and Substance (Hosta)

Chartreuse green rounded leaves. Slug resistant. Relatively sun tolerant. Grows to 36 inches at maturity.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts

SIZE: 36 inches

LOCATION: Partial Sun, Shade **BLOOM TIME:** June, July

SOIL CONDITIONS: Medium, Moist **FLOWER COLOR:** Lavender





Hosta - Wheee! (Hosta 'Wheee!')

Imagine a little girl with long, curly locks twirling around on a merry go round, her hair waving in the wind. That's the visual I get when I think of the delightfully ruffled leaves of this fun new Hosta. Extremely ruffled, cream colored margins extend from the tip of each green leaf all the way down the petiole to the crown. This ruffled margin is evident even in the juvenile stage of the plant before vernalization. The leaves of this medium sized hosta are of excellent substance, making them slug resistant in the landscape. Light lavender flowers appear atop purple scapes in midsummer.

Trim to ground after several frosts.

SIZE: 18-30 inches

LOCATION: Full to Part Shade **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Medium, moist

FLOWER COLOR: Purple





Liriope-Varigated (Liriope muscari 'Variegata')

Small grass like perennial with variegated green/yellow foliage. The blooms look like purple grape hyacinths. Grows 9-12 inches tall, blooms July-August.

Likes dry shade.

Cut back to the ground in Spring, this is a semi-evergreen perennial.

SIZE: 9-12 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun, Shade

BLOOM TIME: July, August **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Dry, Medium **FLOWER COLOR:** Purple







Lythrum (Lythrum vigatum)

People love this plant! It is immensely attractive, bearing beautiful pink-purple spiky perennial that gets 36-60 inches tall. It blooms May-September and therefore often works well as a cut flower. Lythrum loves water!!! Read that as: It spreads and we do not recommend you plant near waterways.

Trim to the ground in the late fall after several frosts. Watch for metalic flea beetles and japanese beetles. Spray with insecticide as needed.

SIZE: 36-60 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: May, June, July, August, September

SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist, Wet **FLOWER COLOR:** Pink, Purple







Lythrum-Dwarf Purple (Lythrum vigatum)

A beautiful pink-purple spiky perennial. The same perennial as regular lythrum except a dwarf variety only reaching 24-30 inches tall. It blooms May thru September. Works well as a cut flower. Lythrum loves water!!! Do not plant near waterways.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts. Watch for metalic flea beetles and japanese beetles. Spray with insecticide as needed.

SIZE: 24-30 inches

LOCATION: Sun, Partial Sun

BLOOM TIME: May, June, July, August, September

SOIL CONDITIONS: Moist, Wet **FLOWER COLOR:** Pink, Purple











Salvia - Crystal Blue (Salvia nemorosa COLOR SPIRES 'Crystal Blue')

A new color for our hardy perennial Salvia! Sky blue flowers adorn the dense, grey-green foliage for a strong pop of color.

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18"-20"

BLOOM TIME: May, June **FLOWER COLOR:** Blue













Salvia - New Dimension Blue (Salvia nemorosa)

A great compact salvia having blue-violet flowers on deep purple stems.

Prune to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 14-18 inches tall **LOCATION:** Sun

SOIL CONDITIONS: Dry, medium

FLOWER COLOR: blue











Salvia - New Dimension Rose (Salvia)

A compact pink blooming salvia!

Cut back after blooming to start reblooming

Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 14-18 inches LOCATION: Sun

BLOOM TIME: May, June, July, August **SOIL CONDITIONS:** Dry, medium

FLOWER COLOR: pink













Salvia Caradonna (Salvia nemorosa 'Caradonna')

You will know this to be one of the perennial sages and it has rich,long blooming, violet-purple flowers on purple spiky stems. Remember to remove the faded blooms to encourage repeat flowering. This plant grows 18-24 inches tall, in other words, medium height. Salvia Caradonna is heat and humidity tolerant!

Trim down 50% after blooming to prevent "flopping" and reblooming. Trim to the ground in late fall after several frosts.

SIZE: 18-24 inches **LOCATION:** Sun

BLOOM TIME: April, may, June, July, Auguust, September

SOIL CONDITIONS: dry to medium

FLOWER COLOR: purple
